What is it?

Located in North Adelaide, between Main North Road and LeFevre Road, Kangatilla (Park 4) project provides a shared use walking and cycling path for people who walk and ride bikes in and through the North Adelaide area.

The new path provides people with an accessible route into the Park Lands, regardless of mobility needs. The new path forms the final part of a local neighbourhood walking and cycling loop through Parks 4 and 5, which connect directly to the North East Park Lands Activity Hub.

Why was it implemented?

The Kangatilla (Park 4) path was part of an existing and planned safe cycling route (bikeways). A new path was required to improve amenity and connection to existing walking and cycling links. This section of the path was implemented to provide:

- o Increased recreation and transport options for residents and visitors, including the Braund Road and Prospect Road Bike Direct Routes, the Park Lands Trail and the north-south Frome Bikeway
- o Increased opportunities for North Adelaide residents to enjoy active recreation pursuits in a natural setting

Project Aims

- o Installation of approximately 530 metres of shared use walking and cycling path
- o Improved amenity and connection to existing walking and cycling routes

Project Budget

The overall project budget was \$220,000 and included \$50,000 in funding from the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure through the 2014/15 State Bicycle Fund.

Project Timeline

- o January 2015: Design for Kangatilla (Park 4) begins
- o March 2015: Design for Kangatilla (Park 4) is completed
- o 27 February 2015: Public consultation on Kangatilla (Park 4) design begins
- o 22 March 2015: Public consultation on Kangatilla (Park 4) design ends
- o 12 May 2015: Council endorses final design of Kangatilla (Park 4)
- o April 2016: Construction begins
- o May 2016: Construction is finalised

Future Stages

Council will continue implementing existing and planned safe cycling routes (bikeways) across the City of Adelaide. All projects are subject to funding, community consultation and Council endorsement.
